

Literacy

Focus - capital letters, full stops. MA & HA - conjunctions. HA - !?

Poetry - seasonal poems and writing our own seasonal poem. Acrostic poetry continuing focus on seasons. A week of work on calligrams focusing on things I love.

Traditional tales - creating storyboard for the story then retelling cook magic pot verbally then writing it. Following this, children innovate their own similar version of the story, again creating a story board, then writing it and performing it.

Non-fiction - cookies have been stolen from Year 1 and the person has been caught on camera!

Retell the events that have happened and act out our own versions. To include drama and hot seating.

Science

Children are taught to work scientifically through the topics of plants and seasonal change.

Plants- focus on what plants are. How to grow plants - what they need to survive. Which plants grow in the UK and where! Plants that grow in different seasons.

Seasonal change - also covered heavily in Literacy through the end of Spring 1 report writing and in Spring 2's seasons poetry.

Enrichment

Maths

Multiplication - solve one step problems involving multiplication using concrete objects and pictorial representations. Focus on 5 x table and creating arrays and beginning to record our answers in a number sentence (focus on the groups of 5 and total number).

Fractions - finding half and quarter of an object, shape or quantity. Focus to be pushed onto quantity to link with measures unit.

Geometry - position, direction and movement including whole, half and 3 quarter turns - use a big class map and direct children around the room. ICT link - children to use computer programming vocab here.

Measures - calculating and recording capacity, weight/mass and continuing time.

History & Geography

Geography focus this term.

Children look at maps of the UK.

The countries that make up the UK and where we are in it. Finger painting the British Isles into different colours for each country. Capital cities in the UK. Knowledge of the seas which surround the UK.

Flags - UK and England.

RE and PSHE

Christianity - focus on who a Christian is, what a church is and basic knowledge about their beliefs (Easter Story). Messy church trip. 40 Acts of Kindness. Friendship (PSHE). What I like about me.
