Children will listen to fictional stories and poems.

Using a capital letter for names of people, places, the days of the week, and the personal pronoun 'I'

Becoming very familiar with key stories, fairy stories and traditional tales, retelling them and considering their particular characteristics.

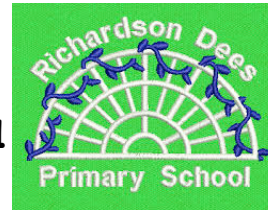
Spell and read the age appropriate common exception words.

Mathematics including Arithmetic

Number and place value

Children will learn to count to and across 100.
They will count, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals.

Children will begin identifying one more and one less.
Children will represent numbers using pictorial representations.

Addition and subtraction

Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving + and -

Science

Materials

Children will be learning all about what a material is, what they might be used for and where they come from. They will do this through a range of investigations, sorting activities and exploring their indoor and outdoor environment.

Children will be taught to think scientifically

Dance - Children will be learning how to move in different ways.
