

English including Grammar

Children will listen to contemporary fiction, stories which may reflect their own experiences. Children will listen to and write poems which build vocabulary and that have a structure of rhyming couplets. Children will also explore non-fiction, including writing a report and writing and following instructions. Children will take part in a phonics scheme called Read Write Inc to improve their knowledge of sounds for reading and writing. Children will continue to learn to leave spaces between words, punctuate sentences using a capital letter and a full stop, question mark or exclamation mark. Using a capital letter for names of people, places, the days of the week, and the personal pronoun 'I' Spell and read the age appropriate common exception words.

Science

Materials will be continued - Children will be learning all about what a material is, what they might be used for and where they come from.

Children will be taught to think scientifically.

Animals including Humans

Children will begin to look at the human body and explore it by identifying, naming, drawing and labeling the basic parts. They will also learn about the senses and which body part is associated with each.

ICT and Computing

Control and programming.
We will be using the program Scratch Junior on the Ipads to program and control characters. The children will design the backgrounds, program the sequences and add sound.
