

Literacy

Fiction

The children will be looking at a short story and using drama consider the main character's thoughts and feelings. We will be using our story writing skills to extend the story and create alternative endings.

Non Fiction

The children will be continuing to learn about non-chronological reports, using the Talk for Writing approach. We will initially be basing our report on a Manchester Ridgeback Dragon and then the children will be creating a dragon of their own!

Science

Children are continuing to look at the topic of **living things and their habitats**.

Children will;

Look at food chains in more detail, thinking about which animal / plant is the producer, prey or predator.

Look at mini beasts, identifying their habitats and having a go at making one!

Using information we have collected on mini beasts and displaying it in a table and graph.
