

Literacy

Year 2 will be taking their SATS this half term.

Fiction

The children will be using the story "Hermelin the Mouse Detective" to explore how different word choices can create different effects, we will also be learning about expanded noun phrases and how these add more detail to our writing.

Poetry

We will be re-visiting riddles and using interesting adjectives to add detail to our clues.

Non Fiction

The children will be reading non-fiction texts and extracting information from these to complete comprehension questions.

Science

Children are taught to learn about **Plants**.

Children will:

Observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.

Investigate how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

Identify and describe the functions of different parts of a flowering plant.

Investigate the way in which water is transported within plants.

PE

Art & DT

Maths

Year 2 will be taking their SATS this half term.

Number and place value - We will be using place value and number facts to solve problems as well as revising counting in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10 from any numbers, forwards and backwards.

Addition and subtraction - We will be using our knowledge and skills of addition and subtraction to answer number sentences that are presented in any order or even have a middle number missing! We will also be looking at the relationship between addition and subtraction.

Measures - We will be looking at time, including thinking about the units we use and how to read both analogue and digital clocks. We will also be revising other units of measure.

History & Geography

Geography focus this half term.

Children recap map of the UK, begin to use geographical language, including beach, cliff, coast etc.

Identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the UK and location of hot and cold areas in the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles.
