

English including Grammar

Children will continue to develop their speaking and listening skills. They will learn to use capital letters when writing proper nouns and the personal pronoun 'I'. Children will learn to write sentences, and will continue to practise their letter formation and learn to leave spaces between words. Children will punctuate their sentences using a capital letter and a full stop.

Children will listen to fictional stories, including The Magic Porridge Pot, and poems. They will become familiar with key stories, fairy stories and traditional tales, retelling them and considering their particular characteristics. Children will also look at non-fiction writing, and will write their own persuasive piece of writing through the Talk for Writing approach. Children will take part in a phonics scheme called Read Write Inc to improve their knowledge of sounds for reading and writing. Children will begin to spell and read the age appropriate common exception words.

Science

Materials will be continued - Children will be learning all about what a material is, what they might be used for and where they come from. Children will be taught to think scientifically.

Animals including Humans

Children will begin to look at the human body and explore it by identifying, naming, drawing and labeling the basic parts. They will also learn about the senses and which body part is associated with each. Children will carry out a range of investigations, in both the indoor and outdoor environment.

ICT and Computing

Control and programming.
We will be using the program Scratch Junior on the I pads to program and control characters. The children will design the backgrounds, program the sequences and add sound.
