Fiction

The children will be looking at a fairy tale and a traditional tale and using this as a base to create their own innovated versions of the story.

Poetry

The children will be looking at calligram poems and the features of these. They will then create their own!

Non Fiction

The children will be learning how to write explanation texts, using Pie Corbett's Talk for Writing approach.

ICT and Computing

Children will be continuing to learn about algorithms and how they are implemented as programs. Children will also begin to learn about programming through LOGO. They will use this to produce sequences of commands.

Maths

Multiplication and Division.

Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables.

Fractions

Recognising, finding, naming and writing fractions of a length, shape, or quantity.

Geometry (position and direction)

Ordering and arranging combinations of mathematical objects in patterns and sequences.

Measures

Recognising and using pounds and pence symbols and combining amounts to make a particular value.

Science

Children are taught to work scientifically through the topic of **Everyday materials and their uses.**

Children will;

Identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses.

Find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.

Find out about some of the physical properties of different materials.

PE

The children will be practicing their skipping skills ahead of the skipping festival next half term.

Art & DT

Children will be creating charcoal drawings of Tudor houses and exploring different media.

Music

Songs for Christmas.
Tempo and pulse.

History & Geography
