Mathematics including Arithmetic

Number and Place Value

Reading and writing numerals in numerals and words up to 1000, recognising place value of digits in 3 digit numbers, and comparing and ordering numbers up to 1000.

Addition and Subtraction

We will continue to develop our knowledge of the column method for addition and subtraction, as well as our reasoning and problem solving skills.

Geometry

We will be drawing and recognising 3D shapes.

Measures

We will be looking at units for measurement.

Science

States of Matter

Compare and group materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases. Observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled, and measure or research the temperature at which this happens in degrees Celsius. Identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and associate the rate of evaporation with temperature.

Art & DT

This half term Year 3 will use sketch books to record their observations when drawing. They will improve their mastery of drawing techniques using a range of materials. They will also learn about great artists in history.

Mood and Movies.

In this unit we will explore how music can create and affect a variety of moods. We will look at movie soundtracks and the types of moods they create. The children will be given the opportunity to create a movie soundtrack.

History & Geography

This half term we will be describing and understanding key aspects of physical geography, including: climate zones, biomes and vegetation belts, rivers, mountains, volcanoes and earthquakes, and the water cycle.

PE

Our coaches will teach PE. They will be teaching gymnastics.

Spanish

The children will continue to learn Spanish and learn basic vocabulary.

RE and PSHCE

PSHCE-Celebrating Differences' look at different cultures, religions, different communities and the vibrancy this brings to life.
